

Table 8: U.S. Export Sales Summary ^{1/}

U.S. export sales in July 1999 were down significantly. Upland cotton sales for delivery in MY 1998/99 during July 8 - July 29, 1999 (4 weeks) registered net sales of 73,100 running bales, a weekly average of 18,275 bales. In MY 1997/98, upland sales during June 26 - July 30, 1998, registered net sales of 246,800 running bales, a weekly average of 49,360 bales. The weekly upland export average through July 29 for MY 1998/99 was 72,000 running bales against MY 1997/98's weekly export average of 132,000 running bales. Accumulated exports through July 29 for MY 1998/99 were 3.76 million bales compared with 6.86 million bales last year. Total upland outstanding sales for MY 1998/99 were 0.51 million running bales compared with 0.76 million the same time a year ago. Upland commitments to date were 4.28 million bales compared with 7.62 million bales last year. Pima export sales during July 8 - July 29 for delivery during MY 1998/99 totaled 12,600 running bales and total net sales were 7,900 running bales. Pima exports through July 29 for MY 1998/99 totaled 275,400 running bales, compared with 420,900 running bales from the same time a year ago. Total Pima commitments amounted to 323,200 running bales.
