

Angola Depends Largely on Broiler Imports to Meet Rising Consumption



Brazil continued to be the lead supplier of whole birds in 2003. The United States is the leading supplier of chicken parts, mainly leg quarters. In 2003, U.S. broiler exports to Angola were a little over 60,000 tons valued at \$32 million.
