Article 1.5: quotas or reference quantities will be increased from January 1, 2002 to January 1, 2005 on the basis of four equal instalments each corresponding to 3% of these amounts.

Article 1.6: the EU may fix a reference quantity in cases where an annual trade review establishes that the volume of imports may cause difficulties on the Community market. The out-of-quota duty will be applied to quantities imported in excess of the quota.
