






# Tropical Products: World Markets and Trade

## World Coffee Production in 2007/08 Down 11.4 Million Bags From Previous Year

## World Coffee Exports in 2007/08 Down From 2006/07 Due to Drop in Supplies

World coffee production in 2007/08 is forecast at 122.9 million bags (60 kilograms or 132.276 pounds), up 4.0 million bags from the first forecast made in June, but down 11.4 million bags from the 2006/07 season. Brazil's coffee production in 2007/08 is now estimated at 37.6 million bags, up 1.4 million bags from the June 2007 forecast but down 9.1 million bags from 2006/07. The decrease in production between 2006/07 and 2007/08 is due primarily to the off-year biennial arabica cycle. Vietnam's coffee crop for 2007/08 is now estimated at 18.1 million bags, up 2 percent from the June forecast. Colombia's coffee production in 2007/08 was unchanged from the June forecast of 12.4 million bags. Indonesia's coffee production for 2007/08 was lowered to 6.7 million bags, down 200,000 bags from the June forecast.

World coffee exports in 2007/08 are forecast to increase 3 percent or 2.6 million bags from the previous 2007/08 forecast. Brazil's total exports of coffee in 2007/08 are forecast at 24.0 million bags, unchanged from the June forecast. Vietnam's exports of coffee in 2007/08 are estimated at 17.6 million bags, down 2.4 million bags from 2006/07. World coffee stocks in 2007/08 in producing-exporting countries are forecast to decline to a low level of 18.3 million bags, mainly the result of lower supplies in Brazil. Stocks have been trending down over the last decade, and this is the lowest level recorded in the USDA database dating back to 1960/61.

In November 2007, coffee prices were near their highest level since May 1998. The monthly average New York spot price for Brazil's arabica coffee (as reported by the International Coffee Organization, ICO) was \$1.1899 per pound in November 2007, down from \$1.2095 per pound in October, and up from \$1.1199 per pound in January 2007. These prices are significantly above the 2002 annual average price of \$.4509 per pound, a year in which coffee prices fell to historic lows.

## COFFEE UPDATES

### **Summary**

World coffee production in 2007/08 is forecast at 122.9 million bags (60 kilograms or 132.276 pounds), up 4.0 million bags from the first forecast made in June, but down 11.4 million bags from the 2006/07 season. Brazil's coffee production in 2007/08 is now estimated at 37.6 million bags, up 1.4 million bags from the June 2007 forecast but down 9.1 million bags from 2006/07. The decrease in production between 2006/07 and 2007/08 is due primarily to the off-year biennial arabica cycle. Vietnam's coffee crop for 2007/08 is now estimated at 18.1 million bags, up 2 percent from the June forecast. Colombia's coffee production in 2007/08 was unchanged from the June forecast of 12.4 million bags. Indonesia's coffee production for 2007/08 was lowered to 6.7 million bags, down 200,000 bags from the June forecast. Other changes in production from the previous forecast include: Ethiopia, up 1.25 million bags; Guatemala, up 350,000 bags; Honduras, up 300,000 bags, and Uganda, up 300,000 bags.

World coffee exports in 2007/08 are forecast to increase 3 percent or 2.6 million bags from the previous 2007/08 forecast. Brazil's total exports of coffee in 2007/08 are forecast at 24.0 million bags, unchanged from the June forecast. Vietnam's exports of coffee in 2007/08 are estimated at 17.6 million bags, down 2.4 million bags from 2006/07. Other changes in exports from the previous forecast include: Vietnam, up 800,000 bags; Ethiopia, up 700,000 bags; Guatemala, up 370,000 bags; Uganda, up 350,000 bags; and Honduras, up 300,000 bags.

World coffee stocks in 2007/08 in producing-exporting countries are forecast to decline to a low level of 18.3 million bags, mainly the result of lower supplies in Brazil. Stocks have been trending down over the last decade, and this is the lowest level recorded in the USDA database dating back to 1960/61.

In November 2007, coffee prices were near their highest level since May 1998. The monthly average New York spot price for Brazil's arabica coffee (as reported by the International Coffee Organization, ICO) was \$1.1899 per pound in November 2007, down from \$1.2095 per pound in October, and up from \$1.1199 per pound in January 2007. These prices are significantly above the 2002 annual average price of \$.4509 per pound, a year in which coffee prices fell to historic lows.

World coffee consumption in 2006/07 is estimated at 131.1 million bags, up 9 percent from the preliminary 2005/06 level—about 97.6 million bags in importing countries and 33.5 million bags in exporting countries. Although USDA does not maintain an official database for importing and consuming countries, world consumption is calculated using the information that is available. World consumption can be estimated based on net exports from producing countries, the change in major importers' stock levels, plus consumption in producer countries. Exports from producing countries are assumed to be consumed in the importing countries, after adjusting for changes in the stock levels in the importing countries.

## United States

U.S. coffee stocks at the end of October 2007 totaled 5.7 million bags, up 62,186 bags from the September 30, 2006, level.

## **Brazil**

Brazil's coffee production for marketing year (MY) 2007/08 is forecast at 37.6 million bags, a 4-percent increase compared to the June estimate. In spite of reported lower husking yields in growing areas such as southern and central-western Minas Gerais and Sao Paulo, updated information from official Brazilian sources and industry contacts indicate higher production in states such as Espirito Santo due to good crop management, plant renewal with improved varieties, and better use of technology including irrigation, thus explaining the overall increase in coffee production from the previous 2007/08 forecast.

## **Vietnam**

Vietnam's coffee production for MY 2007/08 is forecast at 18.1 million bags, a 2-percent increase compared to the June estimate. The government continues its plan of encouraging farmers in marginal growing areas to switch from coffee growing to crops better suited to the soil. However, coffee farmers continue to expand their cultivation of robusta, and where possible, arabica in the face of continued high coffee prices. As a consequence, the demand for breeder coffee trees has increased considerably from previous years. Arabica coffee currently accounts for about 2 percent of Vietnam's total coffee production.

## **Colombia**

Colombia's coffee production for MY 2007/08 is forecast at 12.4 million bags, unchanged from the June estimate. There is no indication at this time that severe rain that caused flash flooding in the main coffee producing region has significantly impacted production.

## **Indonesia**

Indonesia's coffee production for MY 2007/08 is forecast at 6.7 million bags, a 3-percent decrease compared to the June estimate. Arabica production, which accounts for 12 percent of Indonesia's coffee production, is forecast to decline due to low yields caused by farmers picking coffee cherries early following increased coffee prices and due to the destruction of trees due to natural disasters in North Sumatra.
